THANK YOU

More than 30 years ago, Tosco Music was born out of a love of two things: **music** and **community**. What started with a circle of friends gathering in my living room to share songs has grown into a nonprofit organization, and spread like never before. We've seen an increase in diversity in every way, in our performers, scholarship applicants, and audiences.

This past year, we worked with more than 300 musicians and presented 4 Tosco Music Parties at Knight Theater. Our community outreach programs grew to 103 events at 27 different locations, including our monthly open mic, and performances at senior communities.

We expanded our musician support initiatives by awarding over \$12,000 in music scholarships, sending 28 students and young adults to band camps and workshops, helping with music lessons, providing instruments, and much more.

We also presented our annual Beatles festival, FabFest, where fans from across the Southeast **come together** to celebrate the music of the Beatles.

None of this would have been possible without you. You showed up: in person for TMPs and Tosco Music Open Mic, and in giving your resources and volunteering your time.

We're the thriving nonprofit we are today because of **you**, and I'm truly grateful.

As we look ahead, we have many wonderful events and opportunities in the works, and we need you like never before. So, I humbly ask you, whether you've supported us in the past, or are considering doing so for the first time, to partner with us in cultivating local music of all genres, musicians of all ages, and community from all backgrounds...one song at a time.

PROGRAMS

Tosco Music Party

Tosco Music Parties started more than three decades ago in John Tosco's home. Today, music lovers fill Charlotte's Knight Theater for an evening that is as familiar and friendly as it was in John's living room. Musicians of all ages, genres, and backgrounds gather to share their craft with enthusiastic audiences. All TMPs include Tosco Music's trademark singalongs with the audience.



Musician Support

Celebrating music and music-makers is at the core of everything Tosco Music does! Musicians from all walks of life come together on our stages and through our programs in the community. Connections with new audiences and other performers, music scholarships, and paid performance opportunities are just a few of the ways Tosco Music supports musicians.



Tosco Music Open Mic

Tosco Music hosts an eclectic and family-friendly open mic at The Evening Muse. This unique, monthly gathering opens with audience singalongs and welcomes performers of all ages and experience levels to play before an incredibly supportive audience of music lovers.



Community Outreach

Tosco Music provides live music in the community at events that are free and open to the public, at older adult programs throughout Charlotte, and with various community partners. To increase access to the arts for all, Tosco Music makes free TMP tickets available to area nonprofits to include the communities they serve.



FabFest - Charlotte's Beatles Festival

The annual Tosco Music Beatles Tribute sold out consistently over 15 years. In 2019, Tosco Music expanded it to create FabFest, a full weekend of festivities! FabFest draws fans from across the southeast to the Queen City and is well on its way to becoming a unifying community tradition and premier live-music destination event for Charlotte.

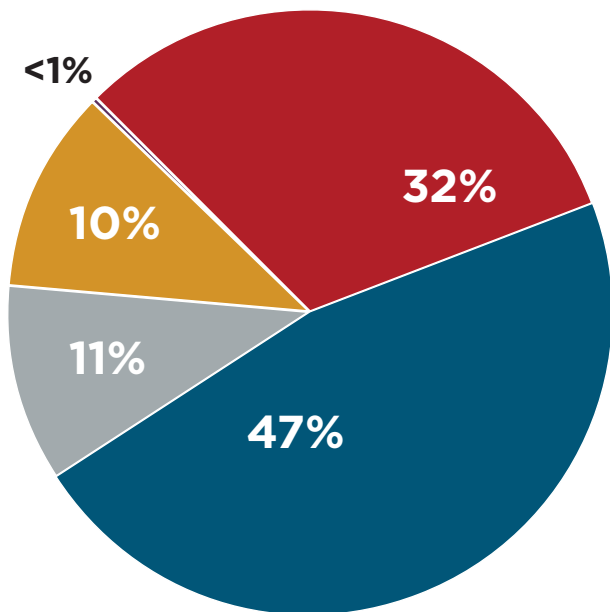

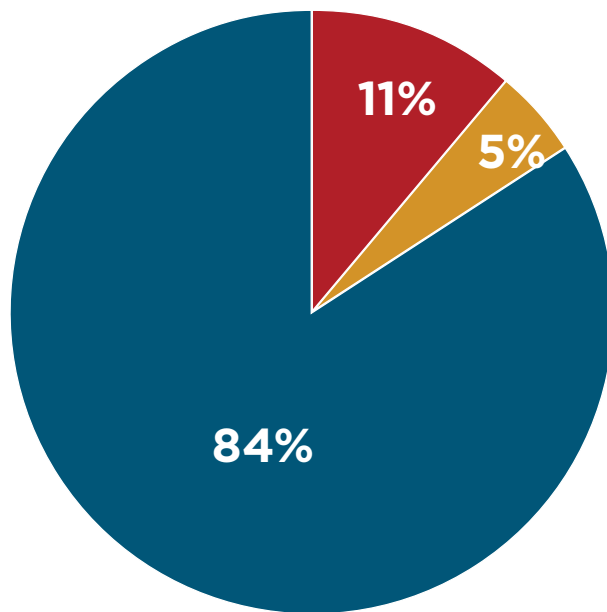
Tosco Music's FY23 unrestricted income and expenses are shown (July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023). Over the past few years, Tosco Music built a financial surplus of greater than \$300K in order to add staff. In FY23, Tosco Music began to dip into surplus for hiring; initial costs are higher as staff becomes trained and experienced. We expect to continue to use this surplus for the next 2 years to reach staffing needs before resuming a balanced budget. Building COMMUNITY

Tosco Music has been building community through music in Charlotte for more than three decades with TMPs, Tosco Music Open Mic, senior programs and performances on stages across the region.

We serve our community with four impact areas: bridging cultures through music, supporting musicians of all ages, drawing audiences to Charlotte, and cultivating audiences across generations.

Our third FabFest in 2022 brought attendees from across the Carolinas and 14 other states, and in 2023 that increased to 18 states! Artists, musicians, and audiences were able to come together for an intergenerational festival focused on community participation.

Another way we create connections in our community is by bringing together artists at Tosco Music Open Mic where wonderful collaborations happen naturally among musicians meeting and supporting each other.

The synergy that happens when musicians of all ages are given channels through which to express their skills is part of the reason we open the stage to musicians of all levels and backgrounds. We look forward to hearing the music they'll continue to create together, and all of the musical collaborations that are yet to come from the next generation of musicians in our city.



Supporting MUSICIANS

Music is best as a shared experience! Growing as a musician requires practice and supportive audiences. It's not unusual for emerging artists to sometimes feel isolated and discouraged.

Tosco Music provides music scholarships and performance opportunities for people of all ages and skill levels, connecting them with other performers and with audiences who are enthusiastic about discovering and supporting musicians of all kinds.

Tosco Music connects travelling artists with local venues and with volunteers who host musicians in their homes. The TMP House Band often backs up solo or young musicians to support their performances. TMP's Green Room offers a catered meal and space to connect with other TMP performers.

In partnership with Music Everywhere CLT, Grindhouse Studios, and Fairplay Music Equity Initiative, Tosco Music presented Charlotte Music Community Hang, a free quarterly event that features opportunities for artists and others in the music industry to network and enjoy a performance, and also features educational panel discussions about overcoming common obstacles that local musicians face.

Music has an unequalled ability to uplift, unite, and entertain. Nurturing YOUNG MUSICIANS

Tosco Music fans the flames of tomorrow's musicians with youth music scholarships and our family-friendly Tosco Music Open Mic. A guitar teacher by trade and Tosco Music's founder, John Tosco has taught thousands of young people the joy of not only playing an instrument but also sharing their music with others onstage. When young people see a musician their age perform on a professional stage, they can begin to envision future possibilities in music for themselves.

GABBY'S STORY

Gabby Fariñas, a fifteen-year-old rising sophomore, moved to Matthews, North Carolina from Havana, Cuba one year ago. A multi-instrumentalist with a passion for music, Gabby began studying percussion in elementary school and quickly progressed to playing clarinet and piano.

She lost her first clarinet teacher in Cuba to COVID-19 but was determined to pursue marching band, JazzArts, and Nuestro Tiempo Latin Jazz Ensemble opportunities when she arrived in the U.S. She recently represented her high school in the All District Band and was the only freshman to do so from her school! This summer, Tosco Music awarded Gabby a Jacob Titus Youth Music Scholarship which covered her expenses to attend a marching band camp at the Western Carolina University Symposium Summer Camp, an opportunity that Gabby said her family would not have been able to afford otherwise.

Gabby has performed at Tosco Music Open Mic several times and each time dazzled the audience with her jazz clarinet skills and her passion for music. Your support allows us to nurture young musicians like Gabby so they can grow into the accomplished musicians they dream to become.



"The history behind playing jazz is that when we came here my mom wanted me to actively keep learning music so she googled music education in the Charlotte area and scholarship opportunities because our economic situation isn't very good. I enjoy playing Latin jazz here because I can use the Cuban style and rhythms and it makes me feel at home. I would love to achieve my goals of being a Cuban American jazz musician."
