Daniel Thrailkill & Jonah Horton

Daniel Thrailkill and Jonah Horton have been playing music together since 2015, forming the progressive bluegrass band, the Trailblazers in 2016. Each have been expanding in their own specific concentrations. Jonah recently recorded and released his debut solo album, *Let In The Light*, and currently is touring with The Kruger Brothers. 
